- 1,500 word maximum
- Gratuitous sex, violence, racism, and promotion of hateful messages will be rejected
- · Writers to sign a release

STYLE GUIDE

- · Times New Roman, 12 pt. font
- Standard paragraph indents
- Double spacing
- Submit a separate cover page with your name, contact details, story title, word count and a bio of 150 words (maximum)
- DO NOT include your name, title, or page numbers on your submission
- Use an editing tool (ProWritingAid, Grammarly, MS Word Editor, Wordtune, etc.)
